Matters Arising:

Events program:

SF has concerns that most events are Plymouth centric, and despite size of committee, we have not had many meetings.

Proposed that we fix dates of committee meetings for whole year, prior to AGM

Does the committee needs extra persons, or do we need to be better organised?

Branch has 2 places at convention(s) which have not been taken – Branches convention is on 18th October.

We should aim to put on 2 big events each year – 1 in Plymouth & 1 in Exeter

Option for joint talk with IISP about “Should Web 2.0 (Facebook/Twitter) be allowed in workplace?”
–Could expand to use of Web 2.0 within small business (esp tourism), but care needed to balance needs of BCS (and branch) members, with wider public promotion.

Base joint event in Plymouth (Mid-end October) and a debate style at The Bridge, Exeter (January)
“Why should I be CITP?” – ask HQ to supply speaker – schedule for Feb, as of interest to student members.

SA – ICT teachers are interested in getting together, could combine with ChildLine. Relevant to both Plymouth & Exeter – so could video link both venues. Ideally September, but too soon to arrange this year, so better in December.

Games development (Plymouth Univ based), also iCub(Tich) – robot baby project

History of Computing - November

AGM at end of September – possibly Mobile computing/Apps – can we get a big name industry player to speak?. Cloud computing another possible topic? Possible date Thur 29th Sept.
SA – Suggests 'DigPen', a new network of developers being brought together in SW.
